

BY-LAW NO. 182A
A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 182
TOWN OF SACKVILLE NOISE BY-LAW

The Council of the Town of Sackville enacts the following by-law:

By-Law No. 182, Town of Sackville Noise By-Law is amended as follows:

1. Section 1 is repealed and replaced with the following:

The purpose of this by-law is to encourage respect for the comfort, privacy and enjoyment of life for residents of the Town by controlling excessive noise.

2. The following subsection is added immediately after subsection 3(1):

- 3(2) *Without restricting the generality of subsection 3(1), any noise or sound of such volume or of such nature as to cause annoyance including shouting, singing, whistling, music, motor vehicles (including motor cycles and motor bikes), snowmobiles, all-terrain vehicles, vehicles of business and trade, construction equipment and animal noises shall be deemed to be noises likely to cause a public nuisance or otherwise disturb inhabitants of the Town or any part of it.*

3. Subsection 6(2) is repealed and replaced with the following:

- 6(2) *A person who violates any provision of this by-law commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of not less than \$100.00 and not more than \$500.00. All such fines shall be recoverable under the Provincial Offences Procedures Act, S.N.B. 1987, c. P-22.1.*

4. This by-law comes into force on the date of final passing thereof.

Read a first time this 10th day of May, 2005.

Read a second time this 13th day of June, 2005.

Read a third time and passed Council this 13th day of June, 2005.
