

BY-LAW NO. 193
A BY-LAW RESPECTING
DANGEROUS OR UNSIGHTLY PREMISES
WITHIN THE TOWN OF SACKVILLE

PASSED: January 10, 2005

BE IT ENACTED the Council of the Town of Sackville as follows:

1. Sections 190.01 to 190.07 of the *Municipalities Act*, Chapter M-22, RSNB, 1973, and amendments thereto, apply to the whole area within the boundaries of the Town of Sackville.
2. By-Law No. 148, A By-Law Respecting Dangerous or Unsightly Premises within the Town of Sackville passed on November 12, 1996, is repealed.
3. The repeal of By-Law No. 148, A By-Law Respecting Dangerous or Unsightly Premises within the Town of Sackville, shall not affect any penalty, forfeiture or liability, incurred before such repeal or any proceeding for enforcing the same completed or pending at the time of repeal; nor shall it repeal, defeat, disturb, invalidate or prejudicially affect any matter or thing whatsoever completed, existing or pending at the time of repeal.
