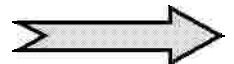

Thus began a passion to research the life of Minudie's "Grindstone King" that led to the completion of an honours thesis in from Mount Allison in 2006. From Dorchester

Follow Hwy 106 east to Sackville. Turn left onto Salem Street and proceed north to intersection with East Main Street. Turn left onto East Main Street and proceed past Tim Horton's (at right), across highway overpass. TRHS is the first driveway on your right. Free parking is available at both levels.

Live Bait Theatre -89 Main Street (Rear of the Tribune Building next to the Save-Easy)

From Tantramar Regional High School

Turn left onto Main Street and follow traffic into the centre of Town; pass straight through the traffic lights and turn into the parking area next to the Save-Easy and park at the back end of that parking lot
