### ***Sustainable Sackville DRAFT now available on-line***

We are pleased to inform Council and public that a working DRAFT of *Sustainable Sackville* is now available for public input and feedback. It is posted to the *Sustainable Sackville* page on the Town's website at [http://www.sackville.com/community/sustainable\\_sackville/](http://www.sackville.com/community/sustainable_sackville/)

The draft includes information on what an ICSP is, some background information on the Town, an outline of the community engagement process and findings. The plan then outlines the vision and sustainability principles that were approved by Council in the spring. The bulk of the document outlines 12 priority areas which were determined through the process. This is then followed by discussion of plan implementation and a proposed decision-making framework.

Council will be working through the DRAFT document at a workshop on September 29th.

A public open house has been set for Wednesday, October 6<sup>th</sup> at the Tantramar Veterans Memorial Civic Centre Lounge, between 4 and 6pm, at which time members of the community are welcomed to view *Sustainable Sackville*, ask questions and provide comments prior to the final version of the document being prepared.
