

BY-LAW NO. 155
A BY-LAW REGULATING THE
DUTIES OF THE TOWN SOLICITOR

The Council of the Town of Sackville, under authority vested in it by section 74(3) of the Municipalities Act, enact as follows;

1. The Town Solicitor shall;
 - a) Be the legal advisor of the Town.
 - b) Be paid at a rate to be determined at the start of the year, for each regular meeting of the Council and for such fees he shall;
 - i) Advise the Committees or the Council at meetings on any legal matter which may arise at that time;
 - ii) Advise the Mayor, any Councillor, the Chief Administrative Officer, the Chief of Police or members of the Police Department on any matter of Town business for which an answer can be given without detailed research.
 - c) Attend meetings of the Council and any Committees thereof whenever required to do so.
 - d) Prepare and attend to the execution of all legal documents of the Town.
 - e) Draft all petitions, memorials and bills promoted by the Council, requiring legislative enactment, and forward the same to their proper destination, and when required to do so, he shall personally superintend the passage of Town bills through the legislature, and
 - f) Attend the Court in the interests of the Town, whenever required by the Council or the Police Department to do so.
2. Any person who is not a member of the Barrister's Society of New Brunswick shall not be appointed or hold the office of Solicitor of a Municipality.
3. It is hereby agreed and understood that wherever in these presents the masculine gender is used it shall be deemed to be and shall be as the feminine gender or neuter

genders if the context so requires; and the feminine gender shall be deemed to be and shall be at the masculine gender or neuter genders if the context so requires.

4. By-Law No. 119, A By-Law Regulating The Duties of The Town Solicitor is hereby repealed.


5. This By-Law comes into force on the date of the final passing thereof.
