

BY-LAW NO. 156
A BY-LAW REGULATING THE
DUTIES OF THE TOWN AUDITOR


The Council of the Town of Sackville, under authority vested in it by Section 74 (2) of the Municipalities Act, enact as follows;

1. There shall be one Auditor for the Town of Sackville who shall be a Chartered Accountant or a Certified General Accountant.
2. The Town Auditor shall;
 - a) Audit, inspect, check and correct the books, accounts and vouchers of the Town, and shall make such examination, prepare and submit such statements and perform such other duties as the Council or the Chief Administrative Officer may from time to time require.
 - b) Have power to demand and receive from any Town officer or from any person receiving or expending, or authorized to receive or expend, Town monies, all such books, records, papers and information as he/she may find necessary for the proper execution of his/her duties.
3. Insure that all sections of the Municipalities Act are adhered to.
4. It is hereby agreed and understood that wherever in these presents the masculine gender is used it shall be deemed to be and shall be as the feminine gender or neuter genders if the context so requires; and the feminine gender shall be deemed to be and shall be at the masculine gender or neuter genders if the context so requires.
5. By-Law No. 120, A By-Law Regulating The Duties of The Town Auditor is hereby repealed.
6. This By-Law comes into force on the date of the final passing thereof.
