

BY-LAW NO. 159

**A BY-LAW TO REGULATE AND GOVERN THE MOVING OF
BUILDINGS UPON OR OVER ANY OF THE PUBLIC STREETS
OF THE TOWN OF SACKVILLE**

Be it enacted by the Town Council of the Town of Sackville as follows:

1. Any person desirous of moving a building upon or over any of the public streets of the Town of Sackville shall make written application on the Town of Sackville form, for such privilege, five days in advance, addressed to the Town Clerk, and therein shall be stated the place from and the place to which it is proposed to move such building and the estimated number of days that the same will be upon such streets. An application for moving a building upon or over any of the public streets of the Town of Sackville shall be made to the Town Clerk in the form prescribed in Schedule "A" attached hereto, or in the said form as amended from time to time by resolution of Council.
2. Upon such application being approved by the Chief Administrative Officer and the Chief of Police, the Town Clerk shall issue a permit to such applicant to move such building over the street or streets in such application mentioned during the period estimated therein, which permit shall be considered the permission of the Chief Administrative Officer to remove such building. A permit to move such building over the street or streets shall be issued by the Town Clerk in the form prescribed in Schedule "B" attached hereto, or in the said form as amended from time to time by resolution of Council.
3. The person moving any building under such permit shall be under the direction and supervision of the Chief Administrative Officer or his designate or the Chief of Police or his designate and for each and every hour that said Chief Administrative Officer or his designate or the Chief of Police or his designate is engaged in the work of directing such moving, the person to whom the permit has been granted shall pay to the Town Treasurer at the Town Office for the use of the appropriate staff the sum as determined by the Chief of Police.
4. If any building, for the moving of which a permit has been granted as herein before provided, shall be or remain on any public street of the Town for a period exceeding twenty-four hours beyond the time mentioned in such permit, the applicant shall be subject to a fine of \$100.00 for each and every day, or part of any day, such building shall be upon such public street, unless in the opinion of the Chief Administrative Officer or the Chief of Police, reasonable effort is being made to move such building in accordance with the spirit and intention of such permit.
5. Any and all damage, injury, destruction or defacement done to the public streets or sidewalks or other public or private property within the Town, caused by the moving of any building under the provisions of the By-Law, shall be repaired in a thorough,

complete and workman like manner by the Town of Sackville and at the expense of and the work shall be invoiced to the person or persons to whom the permit for moving such building has been granted.

6. Nothing in any of the five preceding sections shall be construed as giving any right or privilege of cutting any telegraph or electric light wires or removing any pole or poles belonging thereto, or the right to cross a railway track when moving said building or buildings, but the party applying for permission to move a building or buildings shall make arrangements with the company or companies in regard to said wires and poles and crossing said railway track.

7. Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this By-Law is guilty of an offense punishable on Summary Conviction and liable to a fine or penalty of not less than \$200.00 and not more than \$1,000.00 and in default of payment is liable to imprisonment in accordance with subsection 31(3) of the Summary Convictions Act.

8. It is hereby agreed and understood that wherever in these presents the masculine gender is used it shall be deemed to be and shall be as the feminine gender or neuter genders if the context so requires; and the feminine gender shall be deemed to be and shall be at the masculine gender or neuter genders if the context so requires.

9. By-Law No. 44, A By-Law to Regulate And Govern The Moving of Buildings Upon or Over Any of The Public Streets of The Town of Sackville is hereby repealed.

10. This By-Law comes into force on the date of the final passing thereof.
