

BY-LAW NO. 71

A BY-LAW TO FACILITATE
METRIC CONVERSION

The Council of the Town of Sackville under the authority vested in it by section 7 and 11 of the Municipalities Act, enacts as follows:

1. In this By-Law,

"Canadian system of units" means that system of units set out and defined as Canadian units of measurement in Schedule II to the Weights and Measures Act, chapter 36 of the Statutes of Canada 1970-71-72.

"International System of Units" means that system of units as set out and defined in Schedule I of the Weights and Measures Act, chapter 36 of the Statutes of Canada, 1970-71-72.

2. Every By-Law referred to in any provision of Schedule A of this By-Law is amended by striking out every measurement expressed in the Canadian system of units appearing therein and substituting therefor the corresponding measurement, expressed in the International System of Units, as determined by reference to the conversion figures contained in that provision.

3. Where any By-Law not referred to in Schedule A expresses a measurement in the imperial system of units, that measurement is deemed to be a measurement of equivalent value expressed in the International System of Units, as determined by reference to the conversion factors contained in clause 7 of the National Standard of Canada CAN 3-2234.1-79, entitled the Canadian Metric Practice Guide, and, until such time as that By-Law by actual amendment expresses that measurement in the International System of Units, the measurement deemed to be of equivalent value by this section shall have the same force and effect as if made under the authority of that By-Law.
